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Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (“Enbridge”) respectfully submits this filing in compliance with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission’s (“Commission”) requirement that Enbridge establish a Public Safety Escrow Account with an independent United States financial institution prior to any construction. In relevant part, the Commission’s May 1, 2020 Order and Section 5.5.1 of the Route Permit require:

- a. Within 10 days of this order, Enbridge shall open the Public Safety Escrow Trust Account as described in ordering paragraphs 6, 7, 8, and 9 of the October 2018 RP Order to provide for deposit of a limited preliminary funding; and
- b. Prior to the Executive Secretary determining the “initial amount” to be deposited in the Public Safety Escrow Trust Account, Enbridge shall make a limited preliminary public safety funding deposit in the amount of \$250,000 that may be accessed prior to the Executive Secretary’s determination of the “initial amount” in paragraph 9.B of the October 2018 RP Order.

Enbridge established a Public Safety Escrow Account with an independent third-party financial institution, and an initial amount of \$250,000 was deposited on May 8, 2020.
