For a very small utility like ours, given our limited staff, we will opt to email our response rather than eFile.

The City of Fairfax City Council met on March 19th and implemented the following:

- All utility disconnects are suspended for the next two billing cycles (to be re-evaluated after two have passed for potential extension)
- Businesses and residential customers affected by the pandemic are welcomed to contact City Hall and have their utility bills deferred until the Governor's emergency declaration is lifted. The City will then work with all parties to arrange flexible repayment schedules and timelines which work at the benefit of the customer. No late fees or other burdensome charges will be applied during.
